

Risks and Benefits of CCP

Benefits

- Earn high school and college credit for completed courses
- Reduce the time and cost of earning college credit
- CCP course grades are weighted similar to AP or other advanced standing courses on a high school transcript

Risks

- Grade earned in a CCP course is part of permanent college transcript which can impact federal financial aid as well as college GPA
- Students who fail or withdraw from a College Credit Plus course after the deadline will be charged for the course

****Additional Risks for students taking CCP courses off campus****

- Family is responsible for transportation
- Student becomes solely responsible for course work (parents or guardians are not able to speak with professors and school counselors do not receive updates on grades until the end of the semester)
